

Frequently Asked Questions

Q My questionnaire was damaged in the mail or misplaced, what do I do?

A Second mailings will go out in April for those that weren't returned after the initial form was sent. Just wait for the second notice.

Q Is this a scam?

A No, your name has been drawn by random selection from the Georgia Voter Registration list and you are being considered for jury service in the Middle District of Georgia. Your answers to the questions help us determine whether you are qualified to serve.

Q My son/daughter received this questionnaire and he/she has moved. What do I do?

A If possible, forward the questionnaire to the new address. The 10 -day return deadline will be waived. If it is impossible to forward the questionnaire, you may complete and return. You must note in the remarks that you have completed the form on their behalf. Do not sign the form.

Q My husband is a Sr. and my son is a Jr. How do I know which one the questionnaire is for if it does not indicate Jr. or Sr.?

A If you are both registered to vote in Georgia, please call the Jury Revision Clerk at 478-752-0754 to request a birth date search.

Q My son/daughter is serving in the military. Can I complete the questionnaire for them and return it?

A If possible, forward the questionnaire to the military address. The 10-day return deadline will be waived. If it is impossible to forward the questionnaire, you may complete and return. You must note in the remarks that you have completed the form on their behalf. Do not sign the form.

Q I have never registered to vote, how did my name get selected?

A The Georgia Secretary of State's Office provided the court with a list of names and addresses from the Voter Registration List. The list included all persons registered to vote in the 2008 Presidential Election. Q I moved out of state and the questionnaire was forwarded to me/

A Complete the questionnaire and note in the remarks that you have moved.

Q I don't live in Albany, Athens, Columbus, Macon or Valdosta.

A The Middle District encompasses 70 counties. If you reside in one of those counties, you may be qualified as a potential juror. If you live outside of the Middle District complete the form and note in the remarks that you have moved.
