ORDER

Effective October 1, 2009, Title 28, United States Code, Section 1871(b)(2) provides that a petit juror required to attend more than ten (10) days in hearing one case may be paid an additional fee of \$10.00 for each day in excess of ten (10) days on which he is required to hear such case.

Pursuant to Title 28, United States Code, Section 1871(b)(3), a grand juror may be paid an additional fee not exceeding \$10.00 more than the attendance fee for each day in excess of forty-five (45) days of actual service.

It is ORDERED that the supplemental \$10.00 fee is to be applied automatically as of October 1, 2009, to petit and grand jurors when they reach the statutory minimum for the increase, without prior leave of the court. However, the presiding judge in his discretion may order that the supplemental fee not be paid.
