**FORFEITURE OF COLLATERAL SCHEDULE
FOR MISDEMEANOR AND PETTY OFFENSES**

INTRODUCTION

(a) Pursuant to Rule 58, the Court adopts the attached Forfeiture of Collateral Schedule to fix the sum a defendant may pay in lieu of a court appearance. Where the Schedule designates a mandatory court appearance by the abbreviation “MCA,” a defendant cannot pay a fixed sum in lieu of appearance.

(b) When a defendant pays a fixed sum in lieu of a court appearance, the Court may enter a judgment of conviction for the charged offense.

(c) When a defendant neither pays the fixed sum nor appears when summoned, the Court may administratively forfeit the collateral in the amount of the fixed sum, which shall not equate to a finding of guilt and instead shall signify the defendant neither contests the charge nor requests a hearing. This rule does not apply to MCA offenses.

(d) Any offense for which the government alleges the victim incurred in excess of \$5,000 in related property damages or medical expenses shall be a mandatory court appearance regardless of whether the Schedule designates a fixed sum.

(e) The officer issuing a citation or violation notice may designate any offense as MCA if the circumstances are sufficiently aggravated.

(f) A defendant must appear in court when any proffered form of payment is uncollectible for any reason within the defendant’s control.

(g) Upon a conviction in any case involving wildlife or property seized under the authority of any federal statute, such wildlife or property shall be forfeited to the U.S. Government and disposed of by the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service in such a manner as described by Title 50, Code of Federal Regulations, Part 12.

COLLATERAL SCHEDULE

PART A

AIRPORTS AND AIRCRAFT

Part A is to be used primarily by the Federal Bureau of Investigation and other federal law enforcement officers investigating and enforcing the law within the special aircraft jurisdiction of the United States, as codified in 49 U.S.C. § 46501 and elsewhere. The following schedule applies to all persons within the special aircraft jurisdiction of the United States within the Middle District of Georgia.

Part B is to be used primarily by law enforcement operating on Fort Benning, Robins Air Force Base, Moody Air Force Base, Marine Corps Logistics Base Albany, and other Department of Defense property in the Middle District of Georgia. Part B includes certain offenses arising under the Official Code of Georgia, through 18 U.S.C. §§ 7 and 13, when such offenses are committed within the special maritime or territorial jurisdiction of the United States. Part B also includes offenses arising under the Official Code of Georgia related to fishing, hunting, and trapping, pursuant to 10 U.S.C. § 2671. The following schedule applies to all persons within the special maritime and territorial jurisdiction of the United States within the Middle District of Georgia.
