



Law Student Practice

Pursuant to Local Rule 83.4, an eligible law student may appear in proceedings in the United States District Court for the Middle District of Georgia under the supervision of a member of the Bar of this Court and with the written consent of the party (or the party's representative) on whose behalf the student appears. With permission of the presiding judge, the student may appear in courtroom proceedings provided the supervising attorney is present in court. Submission of the following is required:

Application Forms:

- Student Practice Application (with letter of certification from Law School Dean indicating that the student is qualified to provide legal representation under the local rule, and that the student has completed at least 48 semester hours or 72 quarter hours of academic credit or the equivalent)
- Certification by Supervising Attorney
