ORDER AMENDING LOCAL RULES

Pursuant to rule 83, Federal Rules of Civil Procedure, and by vote of the district judges following public notice and an opportunity for comment, the Local Rules of the United States District Court for the Middle District of Georgia are hereby amended as follows (all new material is underlined):

Amendment

LOCAL RULE 87: CORPORATE DISCLOSURE STATEMENT

87.1 CORPORATE DISCLOSURE STATEMENT. Any nongovernmental corporate party to an action in this court shall file a separate statement identifying all of its parent and subsidiary corporations and listing any publicly held company that owns 10% or more of the party's stock.

87.2 JURISDICTIONAL STATEMENT. In addition to the corporate disclosure, in any civil action asserting jurisdiction based on diversity of citizenship, any corporate party must also file a statement that identifies its state of incorporation and the state in which the corporation has its principal place of business. If any party is an unincorporated association, limited liability company, or partnership, the statement must identify the citizenship of all members, and if any member is itself an unincorporated association, the identity and citizenship of such association's constituents.

87.3 TIME FOR FILING. A party shall file the statements with its initial pleading filed in this court and shall supplement the statement within a reasonable time of any change in the information.
